ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIPS: Up to two scholarships will be awarded. Each scholarship will provide festival registration for the student, a room for the student and an adult chaperone of the student's choosing for Friday and Saturday nights, two sets of meal tickets for the Unicoi Lodge restaurant (three meals Saturday and either Friday night or Sunday morning), and concert tickets for the youth and chaperone.
